**REGULAR BUSINESS MEETING:**

**Today's meeting was the first as we align the Yakima County Interagency Coordinating Council with Investing in Children Coalition**

**Present today were:** Lindsay Boswell, Cindy Carroll, Jill Hilmes, Rebecca Knox, Tracie Hoppis, Karla Pezzarossi, and Roger Wentz; as well as current membership for the Coalition.

Lindsay Boswell called the YCICC portion of the meeting to order at 2:15 PM; all meeting participants introduced themselves and Cindy Carroll, Virginia Mason Memorial program manager, welcomed the group to Children's Village and briefly outlined the commonalities of each group. The YCICC/Early Intervention will be considered a committee of the Investing in Children Coalition.

**Minutes:** Roger Wentz moved to approve the minutes from the June 7, 2018 meeting; Rebecca Knox seconded.

**Items Discussed:**

1. Tracie Hoppis reported on the most recent CHIF (Child Health Insurance Form) state-wide data; the report will be available via email. This data captures the number of children with special needs served by each county's Children with Special Health Care Needs (CSHCN) programs across the state.
2. Karla Pezzarossi gave a report on Early Intervention services at Children's Village. Every school district in Yakima County has contracted with Children's Village to enroll children under the age of 3. Each month, the program receives an average of 100 referrals.
3. Cindy Carroll provided information regarding the ABA (Applied Behavior Analysis) classroom
